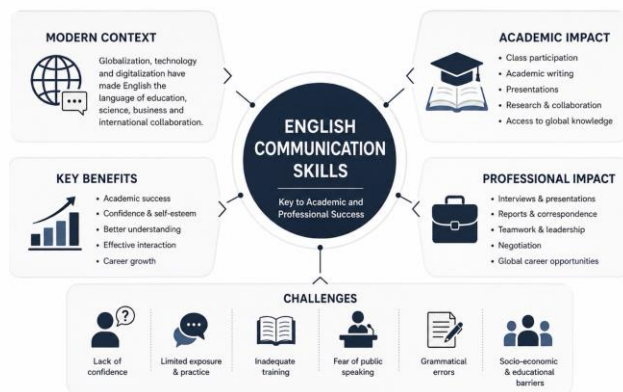


Fig. 1. English Communication Skills
